



# Learn Spanish With Bachata

## How to learn Spanish with Bachata songs



You are a Bachata dancer and you want to learn Spanish!  
Congratulations for making the first step to coming closer to your goal.

So, what is the **fastest and easiest way** for a Bachata dancer to learn Spanish?

Learning **Spanish** through the **Bachata songs!**

Let's find out how you can do that too:

### Step Number 1 - Choose your favorite Bachata songs

In order to learn a new language. We have to learn words and sentence structures. But, compared to a normal Spanish textbook that would be used in traditional Spanish classes, you can use the Bachata songs as your foundation!

Because words are words. They come in all different types from contexts - you can learn the meaning of the word



**bailar** - (to) dance



by taking a regular Spanish class, reading a newspaper article, watching a movie or listening to your favorite Bachata songs!





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So, your first task will be:

**Pick 10 Bachata songs** that you want to use  
in order to learn Spanish

Let's continue:

**Step Number 2 - Identify words and sentences** from the song that are **useful** for you in order to **speak on the dance floor**.

Next, we have a closer **look at the lyrics**. Search for the translation on the web, and **understand the meaning** of the song.

Now you have to start thinking. Which of those words and sentences are useful for me in order to have conversations on the dance floor?

In the beginning, focus on words and sentences of **these areas**:

- meeting and greeting people
- asking for a dance
- accepting and declining a dance
- giving compliments
- making plans to go out dancing
- etc.





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Of course, feel free to modify this list and to add topics that are useful for you.

It is important that you **choose A1 - Level words** and sentences for the beginning and leave out words and sentence structures that are too complicated for now. We can come back to those parts as we advance in our Spanish.

Then, we start learning the words and sentences. There are plenty of different vocabulary learning techniques and memorization strategies that will help you do so. Books, ChatGPT, and Youtube videos are always a great source of information, but you can also ask me if you need some guidance.



So, your second task will be:

**Compile a list** of all the words and sentences that are useful for a Bachata dancer at an A1-Level in order to learn Spanish

Now we move on to the next step:

Step Number 3 - Practice forming sentences with the words and sentences you have compiled in your list!

Based on the songs, you wrote down the words:



quieres - you want

bailar - to dance





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If you put together these words, you get the question:



¿Quieres bailar? – Do you want to dance?



If you need more inspiration what you could say with the words you put together in the list, you could also ask ChatGPT:

-> Can you help me form useful sentences with the words that I have compiled in the following list?

And then you copy and paste the list of words you have created.

And now we move on to the fun part! Find someone to practice the words and sentences with, and try using those words to build your own sentences!



So, your third task will be:

**Form sentences** with your list of words from the Bachata songs and start **practicing** them in real life!

I know that this is **a lot of work..** And what if you have **questions** in between, or **you don't know** which words to choose, or **how to move forward?**

Well, I have **good news** for you! Keep reading :)





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I have put together a whole Spanish A1 beginner course for Bachata dancers, based on conversations you will have on the dance floor and Bachata song lyrics.

I have chosen the right Bachata songs, I have collected all the words and sentences you need in order to speak on the dance floor, I have chosen the perfect structure when you need to learn what, so that you can already have your **first conversation after two weeks!**

Then, I have put everything into 5-min video lessons. These lessons are **INTERACTIVE** - that means I speak to you directly and give you instructions on what to do.

In the videos, I will be asking you to **say things out loud, to repeat after me, to form a sentence** based on these words, etc. You then do it, and I'll show you the solution immediately afterwards.

and all you have to do?



watch one 5-min Spanish lesson per day!



You can do it **whenever it fits you best** depending on your own schedule. Maybe one day you are busy and want to take a break, then the next day you watch two lessons. Maybe on Monday you do it in your lunch break, Tuesday before you go to bed. It is completely up to you!
